## RRRAA Expectation of Coaches:

- Demonstrate professional conduct at all times. Coaches will also require this of the players, parents and fans.
- Always keep the best interest and well being of the children as the highest priority.
- Lead by example in being respectful of other players, coaches, fans, and officials. Coaches are the role model.
- In both victory and defeat, the behavior of the coach shall model grace, dignity and composure. We are a Christian organization, honoring Christ with our words and deeds.
- Place the emotional and physical well being of players ahead of a personal desire or external pressure to win.
- Never publicly demean a player, official, opposing coach or a parent. Treat referees and officials with respect.
- Take reasonable steps to see that all equipment used by their players is safe and conforms to standards.
- Take the initiative in resolving any known or suspected conflict relating to a player or family.
- Accept positive and negative feedback graciously as from the Lord
- Communicate expectations – including these RRRAA expectations – clearly to players and parents.
- Don't run up the score. Getting defeated by a large margin can demoralize other teams, so please use your best judgment when teams are mismatched.
- Understand the rules of the game.
- Be responsible to comply with the rules of the facility being used for practices or games. Ensure that the facility is in better condition than the way you found it.
